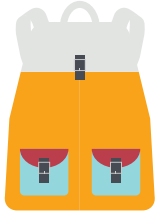


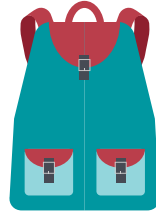
Do Texas public charter schools get more money than ISD schools?

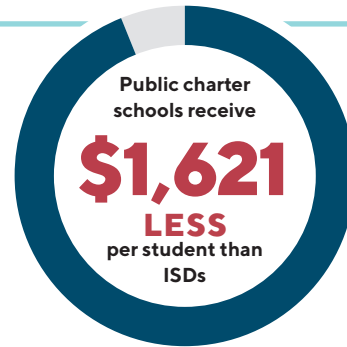
Public charter schools receive less money.



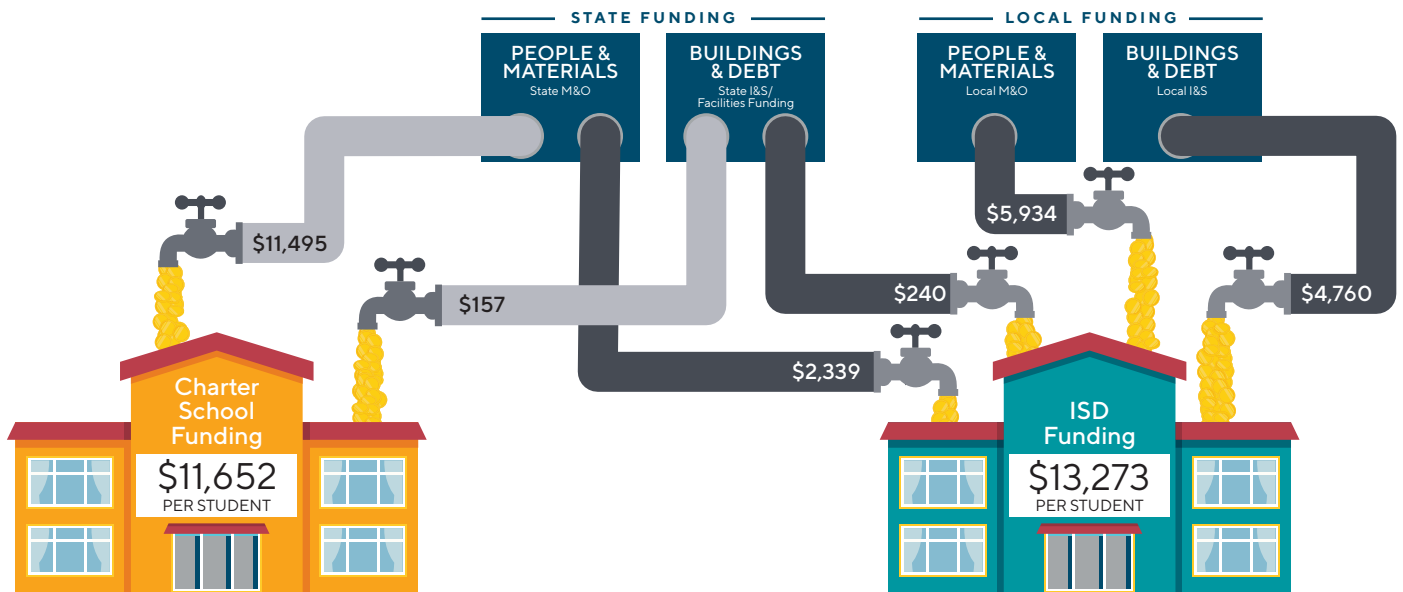
\$11,652
per charter school student



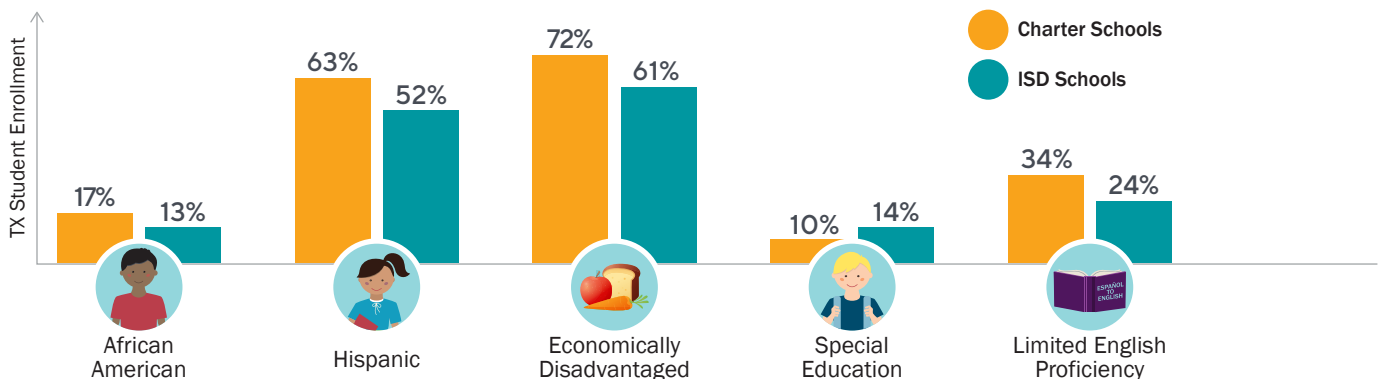
\$13,273
