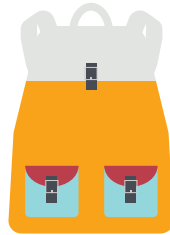
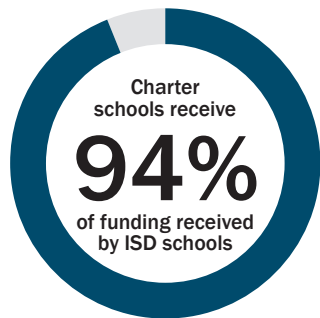


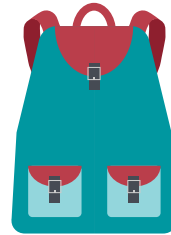
# Do Texas charter schools get more money than ISD schools?

Charter schools receive less money.

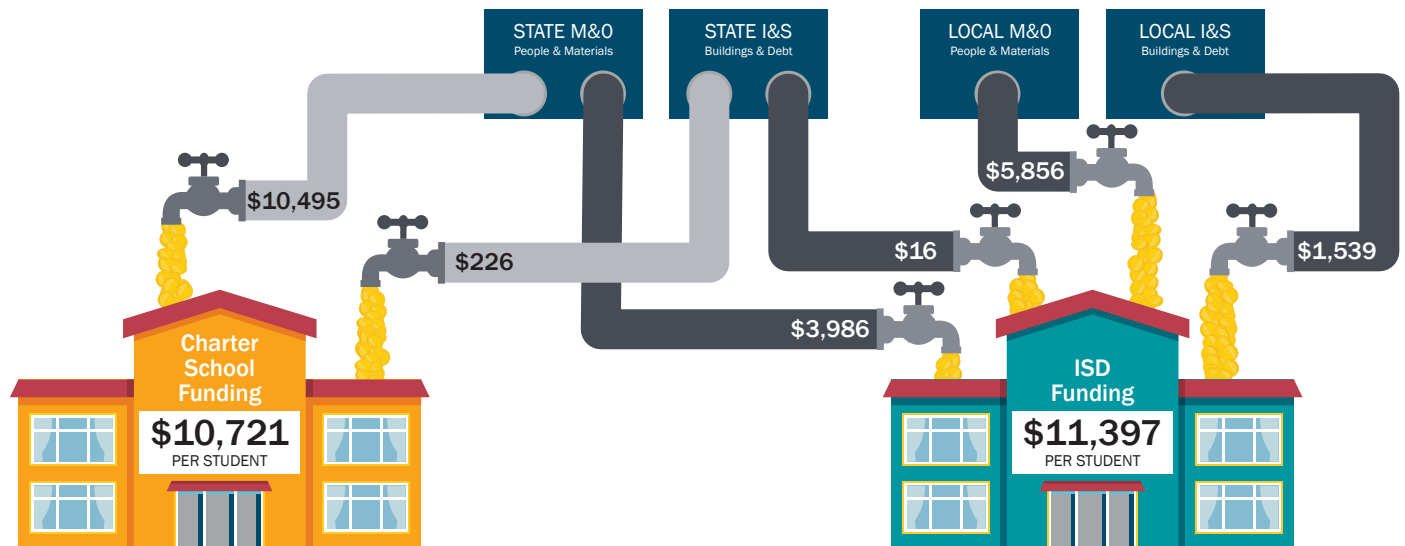


**\$10,721**

school student

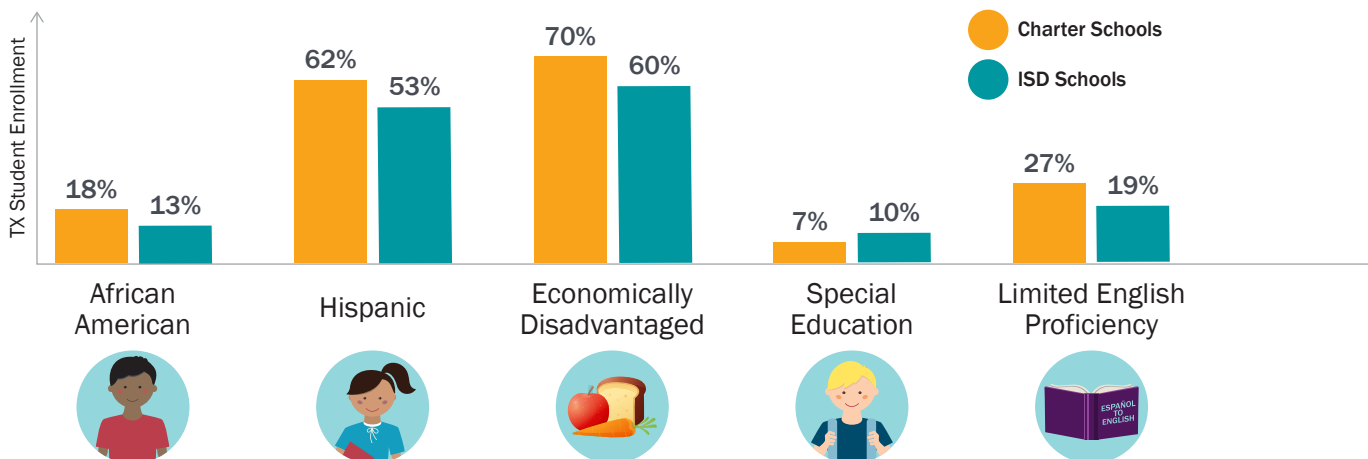


**\$11,397**
