Protect Taxpayer Funds: Air Travel Restrictions & Severance Package Limits

The Problem

When the state legislature recently passed two measures to ensure taxpayer dollars were spent wisely, public charter schools were erroneously left out.

The Solution

Charter schools should be specifically included in rules regarding severance packages for Superintendents and CEOs and the use of taxpayer funds for air travel.



Apply the same standards and penalties to public charter schools as ISDs when it comes to severance payments for superintendents or CEOs.

HB 1320 will: Add public charter school employees and board members to the existing restrictions that apply to all other state-funded schools, clarifying that charter schools may not use taxpayer funds for private or first-class air travel.
